Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) Factsheet





What is Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD)?

Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) is a lifelong developmental disability. Everyone with ASD will share certain persistent difficulties that limit and impair everyday functioning. Those difficulties will affect individuals in very different ways. ASD characteristics can include:

Difficulties with Social Communication and Interaction

People with ASD may have difficulties with interpreting language. They might have limited speech or be 'non-verbal.' Others have good language skills, but find it hard to understand conversations, perhaps repeating what the others say ('echolalia').

People with ASD might have a literal understanding of language, and might struggle with facial expressions, tone of voice, jokes, or sarcasm.

People with ASD may have difficulty recognising or understanding the feelings and intentions of others. They might behave in ways thought to be socially inappropriate.

Repetitive Behaviour and Routines

People with ASD often prefer to have a routine so that they know what is going to happen every day.

Highly-Focused Interests

Many people with ASD have intense and highly-focused interests, often from a young age. These can change over time or be lifelong.

Sensory Sensitivity

People with ASD people may be over- or under-sensitive to sounds, touch, tastes, smells, light, temperatures.

How is ASD Diagnosed?

If you think your child might be showing signs of ASD, speak to your GP or Health Visitor. If your child is at school, you can also contact the school's SENCo for advice.

Your GP cannot formally diagnose ASD, but they can discuss your concerns with you and refer you for an in-depth, multi-disciplinary diagnostic assessment (if deemed necessary).

The assessment will be led by a medical professional, such as a paediatrician, a clinical psychologist, or a psychiatrist. Once the assessment is complete, they will tell you whether or not they think your child has ASD. They normally do this in a written report.

The report might also say if your child presents a particular autism profile, such as an Asperger syndrome or demand avoidant profile, and may give recommendations for support.

Definitions

Asperger Syndrome: A form of ASD. People with Asperger syndrome may have a specific learning difficulty (SpLD), anxiety, or other conditions too. However, they will have an average (or above average) intelligence.

Pathological Demand Avoidance (PDA): A form of ASD. People with PDA may have a specific learning difficulty (SpLD) or other conditions too. However, their central difficulty is that they are driven to avoid everyday demands and expectations to an extreme extent. This avoidance is rooted in an anxiety-based need to be in control.

Learning Disability: ASD is not a learning disability. However, around half of people with ASD may have a learning disability as well. This will affect the level of support they need in their life.

Northamptonshire County Council's SEND Support Service (SSS)

The SEND Support Service (SSS) offers advice and support to children, young people, families, carers, and educational establishments for children with a range of special educational needs and / or autism aged 0-19yrs. They offer free courses and workshops for families (such as 'Spectrum' and 'Reflections') around the county. They can also advise on the Council's various assessments, such as the Early Years Assessment (Portage), the Request for Statutory Assessment (RSA), and the Early Help Assessment (EHA).
